Greening Tool

- Show technologies once sufficiently robust and documented
 - Special focus on return on investment and emission reductions effect
- Allow shipowners to explore how they can make their ship compliant with future emission regulation
- Allow producers to show case their greening technologies
- Allow policy makers insight in the cost of greening options for different ship types and operations

Recent developments

- Further development done by Crup
 - Q4 2015/Q1 2016
 - Easy modification on the back-end side (no need for hard coding)
- Editing actual parameters (such as pricing)
- Editing new techniques (greening options)
- This is a crucial step for bringing actual developments closer to end users

Dissemination

- Promote use of GT through social media
- Tutorial to lower barriers for easy use
- Multilingual (subtitles French, German)
- Embedding tutorial on websites
